Reynoldsburg Community Association Parade Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations have been created to assure the best possible parade for both participants and the viewing public. Safety is our primary concern, as such; the Reynoldsburg Community Association is not responsible for weather related injuries incurred while participating in the parade. Please use your judgment when deciding to participate during inclement weather.

The Reynoldsburg Community Association reserves the right to reject any entry either before or during the parade that does not abide by the published rules and regulations and/or the true purpose and spirit of the 4th of July celebration. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Submit an application to the Reynoldsburg Community Association. You will receive
 confirmation of your application via email. A week prior to the parade date you will
 receive a second email regarding entering and exiting the parade route. On the day of
 the parade you will receive your placement number at the Rosehill Road and Bartlett
 Road intersection from the Parade Marshal.
- 2. The parade begins at Rosehill Road and East Main Streets (promptly) at 10:00 a.m., weather permitting. Line up begins at 9:00 a.m. at Rosehill and Bartlett Road

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALL ENTRANTS:

- 3. Any vehicle(s) displaying advertising and has not paid the commercial entry fee will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. If the truck pulling your entry has a logo, the logo must be covered or will you will be assessed the fee.
- 4. Candy, souvenirs or any other items **MAY NOT BE THROWN** to the crowd due to the danger of children running into the street or viewers being struck in the eye. The prohibitions on throwing will be strictly enforced by the parade officials and the Reynoldsburg Police.
- 5. If passing out materials (candy, flags, flyers, etc.) please have the participants walk along the sides near the spectators and **HAND-TO-HAND** give out the materials.
- 6. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the staging area or along the parade route.
- 7. Automobiles not officially entered in the parade are not permitted in the parade staging area.
- 8. Water guns, "super-soakers," and water balloons are strictly prohibited.
- 9. **During the parade, the driver must maintain 20'- 30' (2-3 car lengths) from the preceding unit.
- 10. **Animals must be listed on the parade application. All animals must have updated vaccinations, be in good medical health and be able to cope with crowds and other animals. The City of Reynoldsburg is NOT responsible for cleaning up after animals. You must provide someone to cleanup immediately, if necessary, after the animals.
- 11. **Any person riding a bicycle, wearing rollerblades, using a skateboard, or other wheeled apparatus, must wear a helmet. No exceptions.
- 12. **No one may step on or off a float or any motorized unit until it is at a **COMPLETE** stop.

FLOATS:

- 13. For safety reasons, all floats must be pulled and a "non-jack knifing" linkage must be used. No driver or any other rider may be concealed inside the float.
- 14. All floats must be equipped with a fire extinguisher.
- 15. All motorized vehicles must be operated by individuals properly licensed for the type of vehicle being used.
- 16. Float decorations may not interfere with a vehicle operator's clear and unobstructed view of the route. Exhaust systems must remain unobstructed. Fire proof or fire retardant construction materials are strongly encouraged.
- 17. Due to low hanging power lines, lights and trees, the overall height of an entry cannot exceed 13'-6".
- 18. All entries that include children must have an adequate number of adult leaders to supervise.
- 19. Floats may not be disassembled at end of parade route (Huber Park).
