

ORDINANCE NO. 10-17

PASSED: February 27, 2017

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR 2017 STREET PROGRAM; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Columbus Asphalt Paving, 1196 Technology Drive, Gahanna, Ohio 43230, in the amount of \$482,564.00 (base bid plus Contingency) for the 2017 Street Program; project costs to be as follows:

Construction	\$438,564.00
Construction Contingency (10%)	\$ 44,000.00
TOTAL	\$482,564.00

SECTION 2. That in order to fund the street program referred to in Section 1, the following appropriations shall be made:

that an amount of \$275,062.00 in the unappropriated Permissive Tax Fund (230) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 230.000.0159.5651; and

that an amount of \$77,210 in the unappropriated Street Fund (260) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 260.000.0159.5651; and

that an amount of \$130,292 in the unappropriated Storm Water Fund (740) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 740.000.0159.5623; and



That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city, and further so that construction can begin as soon as possible in order to be completed this year; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.


