

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL WORKING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF COLUMBUS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Intergovernmental Working Agreement with the City of Columbus to allow the City of Reynoldsburg to operate a VIPER remote system for the City of Reynoldsburg's 9-1-1 emergency dispatching functions through a connection to the VIPER system controller that is currently being utilized by the City of Columbus.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
