

ORDINANCE NO. 12-18

PASSED: January 22, 2018

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH FRANKLIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE MOSQUITO MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FROM JANUARY 1, 2018 TO DECEMBER 31, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with the Franklin County Public Health for mosquito management services for the period beginning January 1, 2018 and remaining in full force until December 31, 2018.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
