

## Please Be A Good Neighbor!

The City of Reynoldsburg continues to receive numerous complaints from its citizens regarding the need to enforce our property maintenance code. Complaints about property maintenance have been raised by the residents in your neighborhood.

Among the most common complaints and violations of the City's code are the following:

- 1) Trash cans or recycling bins along the side of the house;
- 2) Grass that needs to be cut;
- 3) Gutters/downspouts that are in need of repair;
- 4) Accumulation of trash and other debris along the sides, front yard and back yards of homes;
- 5) Inoperable motor vehicles;
- 6) Dilapidated sheds and driveways in need of repair.

*We continue to seek your voluntary assistance to bring your property into compliance with our City code. We have been successful in this regard in many instances and appreciate the efforts of those who have complied. However, compliance has fallen short of what is expected by our residents and required by our code.*

*Therefore, we are asking that you be a good neighbor and maintain your property. We are giving notice that we will be enforcing the code, including the issuance of citations and seeking legal recourse to address those instances where continued violations occur.*
