

Effective June 1, 2006, every voter must provide ONE of the following in order to vote on Election Day:

 **Your Current and Valid Photo Identification**

 **Military Identification with name and current address**

 **Copy of Utility Bill with name and current address**

 **Bank Statement with name and current address**

 **Paycheck with name and current address**

 **Government Check with name and current address**

 **Government Documentation with name and current address**

If you do not know, cannot provide, do not have, or decline to provide proof of identity as required by Ohio law, you will still be permitted to cast a provisional ballot that will be counted if the last 4 digits of your social security number are provided, or you sign an affidavit of identity or provide proof of identity to the Board of Elections no later than 10 days following the election and the provisional ballot otherwise qualifies under Ohio law.
