

ORDINANCE NO. 05-15

PASSED: January 26, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE POLICE CRUISER FOR REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, on December 3, 2014 a drunk driver crashed into cruiser 253 while the officer was operating the cruiser and engaged in a traffic stop; and

Whereas, cruiser 253 was determined unrepairable by insurance; and

Whereas, an amount of \$15,700.00 for the cruiser was added to the General Fund,

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to purchase from Lebanon Ford, 770 Columbus Avenue, Lebanon, Ohio, 45036, one 2015 Ford Explorer four-door AWD Police vehicle, at a cost of \$27,148.00 which is the cost of the cruiser without equipment.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04(c), the purchase shall be made through the State of Ohio Bid Contract Number RS903615 (effective dates 11/25/2014 to 9/30/2015; and competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Hall Public Safety Upfitters, 8495 Estates Ct., Plain City, Ohio 43064, to remove first responder equipment from cruiser 253 for install on newly purchased cruiser at a cost of \$5,772.00.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with REM Communications, 2625 Johnstown Road, Columbus, Ohio 43219 to remove camera and radio systems from cruiser 253 for install on newly purchased cruiser at a cost of \$1080.00.


SECTION 5. That an appropriation of \$34,000.00 be made from the General Fund to Law Enforcement Account Number 110.111.5632.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, and further so the order for the vehicle can be placed immediately; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
