ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO STATE ROUTE 256, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with the Ohio Department of Transportation in regards to improvements to State Route 256 in the amount of \$105,572.00.

SECTION 2. That to fund the project referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$105,572.00 shall be appropriated from the unappropriated CIP Account 410.000.0147.5651.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City, and further to meet the ODOT deadline; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
