

ORDINANCE NO. 19-15

PASSED: March 9, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF \$170,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND TO PAY FOR DAMAGES TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER BUILDINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, recently the Police Department suffered water damage and is in need of repair; and

Whereas, recently the Senior Citizens Center building suffered fire damage which is also in need of repair; and

Whereas, insurance payments will be received at a later date and deposited back into the General Fund account number 110.000.4922 (property damage reimbursements); and

Whereas, appropriations will be adjusted to match the actual expenditures; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an amount of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) in the unappropriated General Fund be appropriated to account number 110.343.5361 (Senior Citizen Center Building Repair/Maintenance).

SECTION 2. That an amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) in the unappropriated General Fund be appropriated to account number 110.111.5361 Police Building Repair/Maintenance.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city, and further that funds need to be in place for the payment of a received invoice, and other invoices to be received; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
