

ORDINANCE NO. 26-15

PASSED: March 28, 2015

ORDINANCE REQUESTING COUNCIL APPROPRIATE \$19,644.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED GENERAL FUND TO COMPUTER DEPARTMENT-MISCELLANEOUS CONTRACT SERVICES, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That an amount of \$19,644.00 in the unappropriated General Fund be and is hereby appropriated to Account 110.584.5339 "Computer Department Misc. Contract Services" in order to pay set up and data storage fees for offsite storage of the City's data.


