

ORDINANCE NO. 32-15

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE UNDERCOVER VEHICLE FOR REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to purchase from Taylor Chevrolet, 2510 N. Memorial Drive, Lancaster, Ohio, 43130, one 2007 Ford F-150 pick-up truck at a cost of \$15,278.50.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Ordinance 94-12 passed December 17, 2012, that waives competitive bidding for various exempted contracts and expenditures over \$10,000, competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, and further so the order for the vehicles can be placed immediately to meet the build out date; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
