

ORDINANCE NO. 69-15

PASSED: July 27, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH EMH&T TO DESIGN AND BID THE LIVINGSTON AVENUE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with EMH&T, 5500 New Albany Road, Columbus, Ohio, 43054, for design and bid services for the 2016 Livingston Avenue Improvement Project in the amount of \$177,456.00.

SECTION 2. That to fund the project referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$177,456.00 will be unappropriated from the CIP Fund (410) and is hereby appropriated to account number 410.000.0150.5651.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city and further to allow the design to begin immediately to keep in line with the OPWC timeline; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
