

ORDINANCE NO. 77-15

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE VEHICLE FOR REYNOLDSBURG COURT LIASON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the 2005 Chrysler 300c used was towed on September 4, 2015; and

Whereas, the vehicle engine was determined as locked up and repairs would run upwards of \$4,000; and

NOW THEREFORE IT BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to purchase from Lindsay Automotive dba Honda East, 5959 Scarborough Blvd, Columbus, Ohio, 43232, one 2011 Honda Accord, at a cost of \$12,000.00.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04(c) competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

SECTION 3. That to fund the purchase referred to in Section 1, an amount of \$12,000.00 in the unappropriated Federal Forfeiture Fund (294) be and is hereby appropriated to account no. 294.111.5529 (Miscellaneous Distributions).


SECTION 4. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, and further so the order for the vehicle can be placed immediately; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
