

ORDINANCE NO. 88-15

PASSED: October 26, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL WORKING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF COLUMBUS TO PROVIDE FLEET MANAGEMENT SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the City of Columbus has on staff Harley Davidson certified mechanics; and

Whereas, the City of Reynoldsburg has 5 Harley Davidson motorcycles in the Police Department's Motor Unit; and

Whereas, the City of Reynoldsburg views this as a sensible way to reduce costs and share services with another local municipality; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Intergovernmental Working Agreement with the City of Columbus for fleet management services.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety and further to be able to have the use of the service as soon as possible; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
