

ORDINANCE NO. 102-15

PASSED: November 23, 2015

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE REYNOLDSBURG DIVISION OF POLICE TO ACCEPT THE 2015-2016 DRUG USE PREVENTION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Reynoldsburg does hereby approve and accept 2015-2016 Drug Use Prevention Program Grant money in the amount of \$30,864.60, from the Ohio Attorney General.

SECTION 2. That grant monies received shall be appropriated according to the grant requirements.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City's government, and further to accept the funds to ensure continuance of the DARE Program; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
