

ORDINANCE NO. 109-15

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT FOR CITY INSURANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract for city insurance for a one year period beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 with Willis of Ohio, Inc. and its related companies in the amount not to exceed one hundred seventy seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$177,500.00).

SECTION 2. That pursuant to CRC Section 8.04 (c), competitive bidding for said insurance is hereby suspended.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city and further that the current policy expires on December 31, 2015; wherefore upon adoption by Council this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
