

ORDINANCE NO. 02-2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BUILDERSCAPE, INC. TO PERFORM IMPROVEMENTS TO THE JFK PARK, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS; the Parks and Recreation department has been working to update and revitalize City part facilities; and

WHEREAS; the JFK Park was approved for a complete renovation including the removal of existing equipment and the installation of new playground equipment; and

WHEREAS; bids were advertised and received to complete the project with the engineer recommending Builderscape, Inc. as the lowest and best bidder for the project at \$1,100,913, with a ten percent contingency budget of \$110,091; and

WHEREAS; this Ordinance appropriates \$1,211,004.00 from the unappropriated CIP fund (410) and appropriates the funds to account 410.000.0172.5639 JFK Park Improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Builderscape, Inc. for the removal and installation of a new playground, restroom facility/concession stand and other improvements.

SECTION 2. That \$1,211,004 be unappropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund (410) and be appropriated to 410.000.0172.5639 JFK Park Improvements.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City's government. Wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
