

RESOLUTION NO. 46-2020

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TAX BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG OHIO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the tax budget of the City of Reynoldsburg, Ohio for the fiscal year 2021 has been presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, said tax budget has been made conveniently available to public inspection for at least ten (10) days by having at least two (2) copies thereof on file with the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has held a Public Hearing on said tax budget of which public notice was given by publication not less than ten (10) days previous to the date thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the said tax budget of the City of Reynoldsburg, State of Ohio, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2021 and ending December 31, 2021, is hereby adopted and approved, and that taxes are levied upon the real and personal property within the City of Reynoldsburg as returned upon the tax duplicate and should be collected for municipal purposes for the fiscal year 2021 as required by said tax budget.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Auditors of Franklin, Licking, and Fairfield Counties of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the expedient financial operation of the city and further for the reason that the official tax budget of the city must be filed with the County Auditor by July 20, 2020; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this resolution shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
