

**ORDINANCE NO. 50-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE A POLICE CRUISER AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE K 9 UNIT WITH THE REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg Police Department requests authorization to purchase a new police cruiser and related equipment for a K 9 unit; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the vehicle, related equipment and a ten percent overrun is a total cost of sixty-eight thousand seven hundred one dollars and sixty-two cents (\$68,701.62); and

WHEREAS, the Reynoldsburg City Council does hereby authorize the purchase of said law enforcement vehicle and further authorizes the Mayor to execute any documentation necessary to effectuate said purchase.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to purchase from Lebanon Ford one (1) 2020 Ford Explorer four-door police K 9 unit vehicle, related equipment with a ten percent overrun at a total cost of sixty-eight thousand seven hundred one dollars and sixty-two cents (\$68,701.62).

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$68,701.62 in the unappropriated General Fund, be and is hereby appropriated to account number 110.111.5632 Motor Vehicles.

SECTION 3. That pursuant to RCO section 175.01(g), the purchase shall be made through the state of Ohio Bid Contract, thereby waiving competitive bidding.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety. Upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon the signature of the Mayor.
