

**ORDINANCE NO. 72-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CITY INSURANCE FOR 2020-2021, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into contract for the City property, liability, automobile and terror insurance coverage for a one year period beginning October 14, 2020 through October 13, 2021 with Willis of Ohio, Inc. and its related companies in the amount not to exceed two hundred fifty-two thousand seven hundred seven dollars (\$252,707.00).

SECTION 2. That pursuant to Reynoldsburg City Code Section 175, competitive bidding for said insurance is hereby suspended.

SECTION 3. That an amount of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) be unappropriated from the General Fund (110) and be appropriated to account 110.595.5351.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
