

ORDINANCE NO. 109-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EMH&T TO CONDUCT SURVEY, DESIGN, ENGINEERING, AND BIDDING SERVICES FOR THE GRAHAM ROAD SIDEWALK EXTENSION (PALMER ROAD TO LIVINGSTON AVENUE) PROJECT AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Whereas, EMH&T will provide survey, engineering, design, and assistance with bidding services for the Graham Road Multi-use Trail/Sidewalk Extension (Palmer Road to Livingston Avenue) Project; and

Whereas, the design will include the extension of a multi-use trail/sidewalk from the southeast corner of Graham and Palmer Roads south to Livingston Avenue, including a stream crossing over an unnamed tributary to the Blacklick Creek, and minor landscape enhancements; and

Whereas, the project will be a collaboration between the City of Reynoldsburg and the Franklin County Engineer; and

Whereas the Franklin County Engineer will provide in kind services as its relates to the design and construction of the stream crossing in that this bridge is a County bridge (operated and maintained by the Franklin County Engineers Office).

NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, that:

Section 1. That the Mayor authorize EMH&T to conduct survey, design, engineering, and bidding services for the Graham Road Multi-use Trail/Sidewalk Extension (Palmer Road to Livingston Avenue) Project.


Section 2. That an amount of \$37,060.00 be approved and taken from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Fund (CIP) account number 410.000.0188.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure.
