

**ORDINANCE NO. 112-2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO REMOVE EQUIPMENT FROM THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET LIST FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg Police Department is requesting the removal of one (1) police cruiser and an Apex Data Collection equipment from the department's fixed assets; and

WHEREAS, this vehicle is no longer functional and not fiscally responsible to make the necessary repairs. The vehicle will be auctioned with proceeds returning to the General Fund.

WHEREAS, the Apex Data Collection equipment is no longer operational and will be destroyed due to the potential sensitive information in the system.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and is hereby authorized to remove the following item from the City's fixed asset list:
