

ORDINANCE NO. 24-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO REMOVE EQUIPMENT FROM THE CITY'S FIXED ASSET LIST, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg Police Department is requesting the removal of two (2) cruisers from the department's fixed asset; and

WHEREAS, these cruisers have been totaled by the insurance company and in order for the City to be reimbursed by the insurance company, the cars have to be turned over to the carrier.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and is hereby authorized to remove the following items from the City's fixed asset list:

SECTION 2. That the Reynoldsburg Police Department will give the cars to the American Zurich Insurance Company for the City to receive insurance reimbursement, which shall be deposited into the General Fund.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
