

ORDINANCE NO. 31-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STRAWSER PAVING COMPANY PERTAINING TO THE 2021 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg received multiple bids for the 2021 Street Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the proposals that were submitted and has determined that the lowest and most responsible bidder for the project is Strawser Paving Company; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has also concluded that Strawser Paving Company has the ability, the resources, and the experience to properly complete the project and has recommended that the contract for the 2021 Street Repair and Maintenance Project be awarded to Strawser Paving Company at a base bid of \$1,464,528.50.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Strawser Paving Company for the 2021 Street Improvement Project for a base bid of \$1,464,528.50 project costs as follows:

Base Bid:

Fallriver Drive, Taylor Mills Drive, Taylor Mills Place,
Linick Drive, Bergenia Drive, JFK Park Parking Lot: \$ 756,802.83

Contract A, Bid #1:

Priestly Drive: \$ 667,662.82

Contract B, Bid #2:

Livingston House Parking Lot \$ 40,062.85

Contingency (5%):

\$ 73,226.43

TOTAL

\$1,537,754.93

SECTION 2. That the following appropriations shall be made:

that an amount of \$1,132,754.93 from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0178.5651 Street Resurfacing; and

that an amount of \$205,000.00 from the unappropriated Storm Water Fund (740) be appropriated to account 740.000.0178.5623 Stormwater Lines; and

that an amount of \$200,000.00 from the unappropriated Permissive Tax Fund (230) be appropriated to account 230.000.0178.5651 Street Resurfacing.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city, and further so that construction can begin as soon as possible in order to be completed this year; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
