

ORDINANCE NO. 32-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH AMERICAN PAVEMENTS INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES PERTAINING TO THE 2021 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, CONTRACT B (CRACK SEALING), APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg received multiple bids for the 2021 Street Improvement Project, Contract B (Crack Sealing); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the proposals that were submitted and has determined that the lowest and most responsible bidder pertaining to Contract B (Crack Sealing) is American Pavement Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has also concluded that American Pavement Inc. has the ability, the resources, and the experience to properly complete the project and has recommended that the contract for the Contract B (Crack Sealing) be awarded to American Pavement Inc. at a base bid of \$64,917.20.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into contract with American Pavement Inc. in the amount of \$64,917.20 for construction services for the 2021 Street Improvement Project Contract B (Crack Sealing).

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$68,163.06 (includes 5% contingency) from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0178.5651 Street Resurfacing.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city to meet contract deadlines and complete the project on schedule; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
