

ORDINANCE NO. 33-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PAVEMENT TECHNOLOGY INC. PERTAINING TO THE 2021 STREET REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE PROJECT, CONTRACT C (ASPHALT REJUVENATION), APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg received multiple bids for the 2021 Street Improvement Project Contract C (Asphalt Rejuvenation); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the proposals that were submitted and has determined that the lowest and most responsible bidder pertaining to Contract C (Asphalt Rejuvenation) is Pavement Technology Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has also concluded that Pavement Technology Inc. has the ability, the resources, and the experience to properly complete the project and has recommended that the contract for the Contract C (Asphalt Rejuvenation) be awarded to Pavement Technology Inc. at a base bid of \$83,030.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into contract with Pavement Technology Inc. in the amount of \$83,030.00 for construction services for the 2021 Street Improvement Project Contract C (Asphalt Rejuvenation).

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$87,181.50 (includes 5% contingency) from the Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0178.5651 Street Resurfacing.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city to meet contract deadlines and complete the project on schedule; wherefore upon adoption by Council, this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
