

ORDINANCE NO. 37-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COMPLETE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION PERTAINING TO THE MAIN STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (DAVIDSON DRIVE TO JACKSON STREET), APPROPRIATING FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg received multiple bids for the Main Street Improvement Project (Davidson Drive to Jackson Street); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the proposals that were submitted and has determined that the lowest and most responsible bidder for the project is Complete General Construction; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has also concluded that Complete General Construction has the ability, the resources, and the experience to properly complete the project and has recommended that the contract for the Main Street Improvement Project (Davidson Drive to Jackson Street) be awarded to Complete General Construction at a base bid of \$3,447,202.83.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Complete General Construction for the main Street Improvement Project (Davidson Drive to Jackson Street) for a base bid of \$3,447,202.83 plus \$172,360.14 for contingency.

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$295,000.00 from the unappropriated Storm Water Fund (740) be appropriated to account 740.000.0170.5623 Stormwater Lines.

SECTION 3. That an amount of \$200,000.00 from the unappropriated Permissive Tax Fund (230) be appropriated to account 230.000.0170.5659 Miscellaneous Infrastructure.

SECTION 4. That an amount of \$952,202.83 from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0170.5659 East Main Street Improvements.

SECTION 5. That an amount of \$172,360.14 from the unappropriated Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) be appropriated to account 410.000.0170.5659 East Main Street Improvements for contingency purposes.

SECTION 6: That to fund the services referred to in Section 1, the Auditor is hereby authorized to appropriate all monies to unappropriated Capital Improvement Project Fund (410) in account 410.000.0150.5651 that are to be received from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) grant program.

SECTION 7. That this ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the city to meet contract deadlines and meet OPWC timelines; wherefore upon adoption by Council this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
