

ORDINANCE NO. 57-2021

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO PURCHASE ONE (1) POLICE CRUISER FOR THE REYNOLDSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Reynoldsburg Police Department has lost two cruisers in the past three months due to accidents not cause by the department;

WHEREAS, the Department has received funds from the insurance company and requests permission to purchase one (1) replacement cruiser using those funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to purchase, from Larkin Greenwood Ford, one (1) 2021 Ford Explorer Police Cruiser at a total cost of forty-seven thousand two hundred ten dollars and thirty cents (\$47,210.30).

SECTION 2. That an amount of \$47,210.30 in the unappropriated General Fund (110), be and is hereby appropriated to account number 110.111.5632 Motor Vehicles.


SECTION 3. That pursuant to RCO section 175.01(g), the purchase shall be made through the State of Ohio Bid Contract RS901519; therefore, competitive bidding by the city is waived.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety and further to replace cruiser 279 which was totaled in an accident; wherefore upon adoption by Council this Ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon signature by the Mayor.
