

ORDINANCE NO. 79-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SEPARATE FUNDS AND ACCOUNTABILITY FOR FEDERAL PROGRAMS AUTHORIZED BY THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Auditor of State Bulletin 2021-004 authorizes the City of Reynoldsburg to establish special revenue funds for the purpose of accumulating resources for the receipt and expenditure of funds from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to create special revenue funds to account for this unexpected revenue and ensure the funds are used to address expenditures only in accordance with federal guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REYNOLDSBURG, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Chart of Accounting for the City of Reynoldsburg shall be amended to include new special revenue funds to address receipts and expenditures activities of the American Rescue Plant Act of 2021.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary for the financial needs of the City. Wherefore, upon adoption by Council, this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon the signature of the Mayor.


